
Dear Mr Bell,

I have been handed your letter by the Information Officer to verify your reception report which you claim to have heard our Station on the 29th May 1987.

I find your report very interesting as it is the second report that I cannot hesitate verifying as being absolutely correct in every way. The first report from South Africa was in 1981. We get many people writing to our Station claiming to have heard our programmes, but not many reports have been verified as correct. The contents of your report does tally with our Station log, and for your information we are using the TR10-2000 Receiver which is a branch of Kenwood, identical to the one you heard our Station on. This is used mainly for receiving World News coverages.

I thank you sincerely for your report which is the fourth correct report we have received since we have been in operation from 1967. I hope that this letter will suffice a QSL card, which I am afraid we just haven't got at the moment.
